

PPA Coaches

A small part of the grant supports the payment of coaches to deliver PE lessons to the children. In total this costs £12,480, with £1,389 of the sports grant being used to fund this.

This allows the children to receive high quality PE lessons across a range of areas for a half term block.

Lunchtime Clubs

Each day different year groups are offered the opportunity to participate in a lunchtime club.

Currently this covers Judo, Tennis, gymnastics and Tri-Golf. This ensures that the children get access to sports that the curriculum can't always offer as well as the opportunity to work with a trained coach. £4,660 is spent on funding this.

Milton Park Primary School works with the Portsmouth School Sports Partnership which is based at Priory School Sports College to support the delivery of high quality sports

CPD for Teachers

Each week a trained REAL PE coach supports a year group to deliver quality PE lessons alongside the teacher. This helps the teacher improve their teaching of PE as well as ensuring that the children receive a high quality PE lesson. £1,872 is spent on this initiative

After School Clubs

We currently offer 2 after school clubs through the funding. These are multiskills and football. This increases the amount of clubs we are able to offer children and gives them the opportunity to receive training from experienced coaches. £1,824 is spent on funding the after school clubs.
